MAIN FUNCTIONS

Monitoring and Control of Air Conditioners

 Air-Conditioning Control System monitors and controls all air conditioners collectively. Air conditioners are categorized by "Block," "Tenant," "Area," and "Unit". Display and setting for each unit are available for blocks of "Whole Building," "Tenant," and "Area". Operation hours of air conditioners are stored in a CompactFlash card.

Energy Monitoring is optionally available by connecting wattmeters.

Furthermore, this system provides interlocking control with a fire alarm and a locking signal, and alarm output through contacts to the external.

Checking and Setting of Operating/Master/Billing **Schedules**

The scheduler controls operation of all air conditioners. Up to 20 times of ON/OFF per day can be set, and setting OFF only can prevent air conditioners from going on running unintentionally. Master schedule allows settings of weekly patterns, four special-day patterns, non-operation days, as well as monthly schedule for 12 months. In addition, billing schedule allows calculating operation hours and Energy Monitoring for in and out of working hours respectively.







Screensaver

The LCD backlight turns off automatically if there is no touch on the screen for about 10 minutes. When you touch the screen while the screensaver is active, touch a corner of the screen because the control buttons on the screen are active all the time.

Before cleaning the display screen, push [Display cleaning] (see page 55). The control buttons become disabled for 30 seconds.

Sets and checks a weekly schedule beginning with the date. Scheduler operation is performed according to the operating schedule. A weekly schedule is copied from the master schedule at 0:00 midnight everyday.

If the master schedule is updated, the updated content will be reflected in the operating schedule one week later. Therefore, always check the operating schedule.


Sets and checks the master schedule. The master schedule comprises a weekly pattern, four types of special days, and non-operation days.

Sets and checks a billing schedule to charge for out of working hours.








Fig. 2-2 Tenants by Block




Fig. 3-2 Areas by Block

Fig. 3-3 Areas by Tenant








Fig. 4-2 Units by All Tenants


Fig. 4-3 Units by Block/Tenant


Fig. 4-4 Units by All Areas




Fig. 4-6 Units by Block/Tenant/Area






Fig. 7-2 Choose Area by Block


Fig. 8-2 Choose from Tenant


Fig. 8-3 Choose from Tenant by Block


Fig. 8-4 Choose from Area


Fig. 8-5 Choose from Area by Tenant




Fig. 10-2 Choose Tenant by Block




Fig. 11-2 Choose from Area by Block




Fig. 11-4 Choose Area from Tenant by Block




Fig. 12-2 Choose from Tenant


Fig. 12-3 Choose from Tenant by Block


Fig. 12-4 Choose from Area


The following describes settings of operation mode, fan speed, set temperature, R/C control, etc. Push [SET] - [Set All Units] to open the screen shown left. (Refer to 9 to 13 for operations to display the setting screen.)

For blank items, the current settings of each air conditioner are continuously valid. When performing total setting for all units, be careful that the displayed settings are valid for all selected air conditioners as control settings.


[Setting]

- ① Set operation mode, fan speed, set temperature and other items individually.
- ② Push [OK]. The settings are transmitted and the setting screen closes. If you push [Cancel], the setting screen closes with no settings transmitted.

15 Indicating alarm/filter sign

Select an alarm air conditioner, and ① push [CHECK]. An alarm indication or filter sign appears on the screen.

(The CHECK button is not available when block, tenant or area is selected.)

When an air conditioner with no alarm is selected, no alarm is indicated.

- ② Push [Confirm] to return to the previous screen.
- ③ When [Reset] is pushed, an alarm clear signal is transmitted to the alarm air conditioner to clear the alarm signal. A confirmation message appears before the alarm clear signal is transmitted.

If both an alarm and filter sign occur simultaneously, alarm indication takes precedence.

Fig. 16-1 Schedule Screen




Fig. 16-2 Operating Schedule Check Screen





Fig. 16-3 Selection from All Units



16 Checking operating schedule

- ① Push [SCHEDULE].
 The Schedule screen (Fig. 16-1) appears.
 To close this screen, push [MAIN].
- ② Push [Operating Schedule]. The Operating Schedule Check screen (Fig. 16-2) appears.

Black line ON to OFF Green line ON only Red line OFF only

- ③ When [ALL UNITS] is pushed, a list of all units is displayed (Fig. 16-3).
- 4 Choose an air conditioner whose schedule you want to check.
- ⑤ When the list ranges over two or more pages, use the [▲ Previous] and [▼ Next] buttons. If you choose no air conditioner, push [Cancel].
- 6 Push [OK] after choosing an air conditioner.
- 7 Push [Return to menu] to return to the Schedule screen (Fig. 16-1).

Fig. 17-1 Operating Schedule Check Screen




Fig. 17-2 Operating Schedule Setting Screen





Fig. 17-3 Operating Schedule Detail Setting Screen



17 Setting/changing/deleting operating schedule

 Push a day of the week button.
 The Operating Schedule Setting screen (Fig. 17-2) appears.

<Addition>

- ② Push [Addition]. The Operating Schedule Detail Setting screen (Fig. 17-3) appears.
- ③ Set time for operation ON or OFF with the ▲ and ▼ buttons.
- ④ Push [ON] to run or [OFF] to stop. To undo the setting to the previous state, push [Undo].
- ⑤ Confirm the setting, and then push [OK] on the Detail Setting screen. If you do not add the operating schedule, push [Cancel] on the Detail Setting screen.

<Change>

- 6 Push a number (1 to 20) whose operating schedule you want to change. The schedule list ranges on two pages.





Fig. 18-2 "Copy to Other Section" Screen




Fig. 18-4 Tenant Select Screen






Fig. 18-6 Unit Select Screen




Fig. 20-2 Checking Weekly Pattern





Fig. 20-3 Selection from All Units




Fig. 21-2 Checking Special-day Pattern





Fig. 21-3 Selection from All Units




Fig. 22-2 Checking Monthly Pattern





Fig. 22-3 Selection from All Units




Fig. 23-2 Weekly Pattern Setting Screen





Fig. 23-3 Master Schedule Detail Setting Screen






Fig. 24-2 Special-day Pattern Setting Screen





Fig. 24-3 Master Schedule Detail Setting Screen





Fig. 25-2 Monthly Pattern Setting Screen




Fig. 26-2 "Copy to Other Section" Screen





Fig. 26-3 Block Select Screen






Fig. 26-6 Unit Select Screen




Fig. 28-2 Checking Weekly Pattern





Fig. 28-3 Selection from All Units







Fig. 29-2 Checking Special-day y Pattern






Fig. 30-1 Schedule Screen




Fig. 31-1 Weekly Pattern Check Screen




Fig. 31-2 Weekly Pattern Setting Screen





Fig. 31-3 Billing Schedule Detail Setting Screen



Fig. 32-1 Special-day Pattern Check Screen




Fig. 32-2 Special-day Pattern Setting Screen





Fig. 32-3 Billing Schedule Detail Setting Screen







Fig. 33-2 Monthly Pattern Setting Screen




Fig. 34-2 "Copy to Other Section" Screen





Fig. 34-3 Block Select Screen




Fig. 34-5 Area Select Screen






Fig. 34-6 Unit Select Screen







Fig. 37-2 Alarm History List Screen





Fig. 38-2 Scheduler Operation Setting Screen




Fig. 39-1 Menu Screen





Fig. 39-2 Display Cleaning Screen

Fig. 40-1 Menu Screen





Fig. 40-2 Confirmation Message Screen

Fig. 41-1 Menu Screen





Fig. 41-2 Confirmation Message Screen

Fig. 42-1 Menu Screen





Fig. 42-2 Confirmation Message Screen

Fig. 43-1 Menu Screen





Fig. 43-2 Clock/Calendar Setting Screen





Fig. 44-1 Menu Screen





Reading Monthly Report Data and Energy Monitoring Data


Monthly report data and Energy Monitoring data are stored in a CompactFlash (CF) card. To output Energy Monitoring result, it is necessary to connect a computer using a LAN. Please contact your dealer in that case.

You can remove a CF card when reading data directly or copying data for backup. Power off the Touch Screen Controller before removing the CF card.

After data read or data copy ends, reinstall the CF card and then turn on the power to restart the system.

<Removing CF Card>

- (1) Turn off the power of the Touch Screen Controller, and unplug the power cord.
- 2) Remove the CF card from the Controller.




Push the eject lever of the slot where the CF card is inserted.

The lever pops up.

Push the lever again to remove the CF card.

<Reinstalling CF Card>

Insert the CF card into the slot of the Controller, and then power on the Controller.



Insert the CF card with its label side facing the rear side of the Controller.

It can be inserted into either of the slots.

The eject lever is locked down when the CF card is inserted.

The screen display returns to the previous state in a few minutes.

If not, the CF card is not installed properly. Check installation of the CF card. Finish handling the CF card as quickly as possible because the operation time of air conditioners is not counted while the power is off.

Note

A CF stores data of recent three months. The data of three month ago is deleted every day at the end of the day.

Is heating (or cooling) operation selected with the mode selection menu on the Menu screen? → Refer to 44 "Selecting cooling or heating mode".
